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# Miraculous cosmetic oil

## 1 For skin care

**Hydrating, emollient, softening:** Hemp oil has a composition similar to that of lipids in skin, enabling to reduce skin water loss and protect it from dehydration. Hemp oil is particularly recommended for dry and atopic skin. It is also ideal for moisturizing and nourishing damaged hands.

**Soothing:** Hemp oil fatty acids, especially omega-3 and 6, play a major role in the skin barrier function and contribute to its anti-inflammatory properties of hemp oil. They thus soothe irritations and redness of sensitive skin.

**Regenerating, revitalizing, anti-wrinkle:** Hemp oil content in vitamin E natural antioxidant (tocopherols) makes it an excellent anti-aging active. This property combined with that of skin repair allows this oil to fight effectively against the signs of aging of the skin.

## 2 To sublimate hair

**Shine and softness:** the essential fatty acids of Hemp oil are particularly useful in hair care to deeply nourish dry hair and get shiny and supple hair.

## *A unique composition*

**With approximately 75% polyunsaturated fatty acid, hemp oil composition is unique:**

- Stearic acid : 1 – 5 %
- Palmitic acid : 4 – 10 %
- Oleic Acid (omega 9) : 5 – 20 %
- Linoleic Acid (omega 6) : 45 – 65 %
- Alpha linolenic Acid (omega 3) : 14 – 30 %
- Gamma linolenic acid : < 5 %

*The unsaponifiable fraction of hemp oil also consists of other molecules with cosmetic properties ideal for skin care: in particular powerful antioxidants such as tocopherols (vitamin E), carotenoids and phytosterols.*

## Did you know ?

Native to Asia, hemp is one of the first plants to have been cultivated by humans.

Only hemp leaves and flowers produce cannabidoids, including THC, the molecule with psychotropic properties. Hemp oil from the seeds of fiber-type (classified as the type 3) does not content any cannabidoids!

Hemp oil is a food oil with nutritional properties highly sought after for health.
